## Legal Entity

bunny.net is operated by **BunnyWay, informacijske storitve d.o.o.** (abbreviated as *BunnyWay d.o.o.*). The company type suffix *d.o.o.* stands for *družba z omejeno odgovornostjo*, the Slovenian equivalent of a limited liability company (LLC).

The company maintains two known registered addresses:

- **Primary registered office:** Dunajska cesta 165, 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia
- **Data protection contact:** Cesta komandanta Staneta 4A, 1215 Medvode, Slovenia

BunnyWay d.o.o. also operates the autonomous system **AS200325** under its full legal name, confirming direct ownership of its network infrastructure.

## Founders & Leadership

bunny.net was co-founded by:

- **Lovrenc Gregor** ■■■
- **Dejan Grofelnik Pelzel** — also listed as Key Principal (Dun & Bradstreet)

The company was founded in **2014–2015** (sources vary slightly) with the stated goal of providing affordable, developer-friendly content delivery services.

## Ownership Structure

bunny.net is a **privately held, venture capital-backed** company. It is not publicly traded. As of the most recent available data:

- **Total funding raised:** approximately \$5.88 million USD ( $\approx$  EUR 6 million)
- **Funding round:** Series A (October 2022)

Known investors include:

- **Runa Capital** — an international venture capital firm
- **Capital Genetics** — a Slovenian venture capital fund

There is no indication of any acquisition, parent-company ownership, or affiliation with a larger technology conglomerate. The company appears to remain independently operated by its founders.

# Jurisdiction

## Slovenia (European Union)

BunnyWay d.o.o. is incorporated and headquartered in **Slovenia**, which is a full member state of the **European Union**. This has several important implications:

- The company is subject to **EU law**, including regulations governing technology and data services.
- Slovenian corporate and commercial law governs the entity itself.
- Dispute resolution and legal proceedings fall under Slovenian courts.

## Data Protection & GDPR

Because bunny.net is established in an EU member state, it falls directly under the **General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)** (EU 2016/679) — it does not require transfer mechanisms to be considered "in scope" as it is already subject to EU data protection law.

Key data protection details:

- bunny.net publishes a formal **Data Processing Agreement (DPA)** in accordance with Article 28 GDPR, designating the client as data controller and bunny.net as data processor.
- The supervisory authority with jurisdiction is the **Information Commissioner of the Republic of Slovenia** (*Informacijski pooblaščenec*).
- Data subjects have standard GDPR rights (access, rectification, erasure, restriction) exercisable by contacting [support@bunny.net](mailto:support@bunny.net).
- The company's privacy policy notes compliance with GDPR obligations for cross-border data transfers outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

## Terms of Service Jurisdiction

bunny.net's Terms of Service designate **Slovenian law** as the governing law. DMCA notices are addressed to BunnyWay d.o.o. at the Ljubljana address, indicating the company also engages with US copyright law in its operational capacity despite not being a US entity.
